



## Rules of the children's playspace with professional supervision

- 1** These rules regulate the mutual conditions governing the legal relations between the operator of the dance studio Moving World (hereinafter referred to as the Studio) Ing. Kateřina Hajičová, with a place of business Hvozdnická 1049/6, 100 00, Praha 10 - Strašnice, IČO: 639 32 181, DIČ: CZ7362260433. Ing. Kateřina Hajičová is a natural person doing business according to the Trade Licensing Act not registered in the Commercial Register and his visitors when placing a child in a Studio's children's playspace.
- 2** Children's playspace is designed for children aged 3 to 8 years.
- 3** The capacity of the children's playspace is 8 children.
- 4** The children's play area is open from 11 am to 7 pm on Mondays to Thursdays. The parent or legal representative is obliged to pick up the child 5 minutes before the end of the opening hours of the children's playspace. If the child is not picked up 30 minutes after the end of the operating hours and it is impossible to find the child's parents, the professional supervisor, after contacting the operator, is obliged to report this fact to the Police of the Czech Republic.
- 5** The parent must state his telephone number in the child's documentation and MUST be reachable on this number throughout the child's stay in the children's playspace.
- 6** A child who is to be looked after by professional supervision must always be accompanied to the children's playspace by his / her parent or other legal representatives, or a person listed in the Affidavit. If this is not the case, the person who brought the child must hand over a Affidavit from the child's parent to the staff. The Affidavit will include a statement from the parent that he/she agrees with the child's stay in the children's playspace, the data of the person who brought the child into the children's playspace (name, surname, birth number, ID number or passport). The Affidavit will also state who will pick up the child after the babysitting period, including the telephone number of this person.
- 7** When the child is handed over to the children's playspace, his / her parent or representative will fill in the "handing over" form, and upon his / her arrival will confirm this fact to the children's playspace staff also in writing.
- 8** When placing the child in a children's playspace, parents are obliged to bring the child a sufficient amount of fluids and possible hygiene items (handkerchiefs, sanitary napkins, etc.), especially with regard to the child's length of stay in the children's playspace, the child's age and the child's needs. These items should be marked with the child's name tag.
- 9** Professional supervision provides primarily babysitting. After an agreement with the parent, it is possible to serve the child with small snacks - drinks or assisting with hygiene needs taking to the bathroom.
- 10** In case that medicines are to be administered to a child handed over to a children's playspace regularly, medication shall be administered exclusively by the parent. Professional supervision is not allowed to give children any medication.
- 11** Parents or representatives are obliged to stick with the pre-agreed period of stay. If parents or representatives need to extend this time during babysitting, they will contact the studio reception. It decides whether the capacity of the children's playspace allows this extension.
- 12** The professional supervision reserves the right to exclude an unmanageable child (a child who repeatedly does not respond to verbal stimuli of supervision, is aggressive towards other children, refuses to cooperate). The professional supervisor contacts the parent, informs him of this fact and asks him to pick up the child from the children's playspace. If the parent or representative does not do so, the child can be excluded from other possible stays in the children's playspace.
- 13** The parent or other adult handing over the child must always prove himself/herself with an appropriate identity document. Professional supervision or Studio's reception are obliged to check these facts both when handing over the child and when picking up the child by the parent or another authorized adult.

- 14 Payment for the child's stay in the children's playspace is made at the Studio's reception according to the valid pricelist. In case of any outstanding obligations of the parent to the studio, the staff of the children's playspace is entitled to refuse the child's further stay in the children's playspace.
- 15 Entry to the children's playspace is not allowed if there is no supervision.
- 16 A child with an infectious disease or cold is not allowed to enter the children's playspace. The parent is obliged to inform the supervisor of any known allergies of the child or other health problems that could negatively affect the child's stay in the children's playspace. The children's playspace staff is entitled to refuse entry to the children's playspace to children with visible health problems (runny nose, cough, fever, skin diseases, etc.) or to children for whom lice will be identified. If the symptoms described in the previous sentence are found during the child's stay in the children's playspace, the children's playspace's staff is entitled to contact the parents immediately and request to leave the children's playspace.
- 17 The child (if it is possible concerning his age) is obliged to immediately inform the supervisor of any health problems that have occurred during his stay in the children's playspace.
- 18 Entry to the children's playspace is not allowed with:
  - bicycles, skates, skateboards, scooters, etc.
  - animals
  - food (of all kinds), chewing gum or candy
- 19 A child supervised in a children's playspace must not carry any sharp objects or valuables with him or her.
- 20 It is not allowed to use any objects (sharp, hot) in the children's playspace that could endanger the health and safety of the child or other children placed in the children's playspace. Otherwise, the supervisor is entitled to exclude such a child from the children's playspace without the entrance fee compensation. The child is obliged to be disciplined in the children's playspace, with regard to other children, to follow the instructions of supervision, not to endanger himself or other children by his behaviour. Otherwise, the supervisor is entitled to exclude such a child from the children's playspace without the entrance fee compensation.
- 21 The child is not allowed to damage the equipment of the children's playspace in any way. Otherwise, it will be excluded from the children's playspace without entrance fee compensation. If the equipment of the children's playspace is damaged, the Studio may deduce from the damage in question the liability of the legal representative according to Act No. 89/2012 Coll., The Civil Code, as amended.
- 22 There is a strict ban on making any video recordings in the children's playspace.
- 23 The children's playspace is intended exclusively for the children to stay. Parents (or other persons accompanying children) are not allowed in the children's playspace.
